

Policy on Continuing Education Credit for Internet-Based Training

Because of the difficulty in determining how many hours it takes an individual to complete an Internet-based training course, the Board will not grant continuing education credit to any Internet-based training course for which the developer or sponsor does not declare how many hours the course should take to be successfully completed.

If an Internet-based course has a range of time to successfully complete the course, the Board will use the mean of the range of values declared (i.e. a course for which the sponsor declares will take from 4-6 hours to successfully complete will be given credit for 5 hours).
