RS BOARD MEETING MINUTES December 14, 2005

Board Meeting

The meeting of the N.C. State Board of Sanitarian Examiners was held on Wednesday, December 14, 2005 at 9:00 a.m. in Room 1A201 Parker Lincoln Building, Raleigh. Those in attendance were: Nilla Sloop, Malcolm Blalock, Ann Gilstrap, Terry Pierce, Sheila Nichols, Perry Solice, Mack Dendy, Dr. Burton Ogle, Layton Long, Janice Jones and John Barkley.

<u>Called to Order</u> - Nilla Sloop, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 9:04 a.m.

<u>Conflict of Interest Statement</u> - Nilla Sloop asked Board Members if there were any conflicts of interest or potential conflicts of interest since the last meeting. There were no conflicts of interest stated.

Approval of the October 20, 2005 Minutes -

Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to approve the October 20, 2005 Minutes with corrections. All votes affirmative. Motion made and seconded to approve the October 21, 2005 Minutes with correction. All votes affirmative. Motion made and seconded to approve Closed Session Minutes. All votes affirmative.

Approval of the Quarterly Financial Report –

Janice Jones presented the Quarterly Report for July 1–Sept 30 and another report on the current balances as of December 12, 2005.

Board Action: <u>A motion was made by Mack Dendy and seconded by Ann Gilstrap to approve the Quarterly Financial Report.</u> All votes affirmative.

Chair's Report - Nilla Sloop

- Ms. Sloop reported on a letter she had received from the Budget Office requesting if the Board does
 civil penalties. She responded to them that the Board is restricted by law from doing any civil
 penalties.
- She brought up the topic of other groups wanting links on our website. The consensus of the Board is not to put multiple links on our website.
- Sloop bought up the topic of a report compiled by NEHA relating to RS Boards. She asked Malcolm Blalock who was working with Christy Robb at NEHA to report on this subject.
- Mr. Blalock reported that NEHA had prepared a document on all the RS Boards across the nation. He reported that there were a number of errors pertaining to North Carolina. He asked Ms. Robb to make corrections that he provided to her.

<u>Vice-Chair's Report – Terry Pierce</u>

- Terry Pierce brought up the subject of renewals and renewal cards. After some discussion, Malcolm Blalock made a motion that after 2006, renewal cards would no longer be issued. Motion was seconded and approved with Mack Dendy opposing. Further discussion on this matter ensued. Ann Gilstrap made a motion that beginning in 2007 the Board would supply a permanent card one time for all Registered Sanitarians as a substitute of the annual renewal card. Malcolm Blalock seconded the motion. All votes affirmative.
- Mr. Pierce discussed the improvements to CIT for 2006. The training room has been enlarged. Food & Lodging Modules will be offered two times and Onsite Module will be offered 3 times annually.
- Mr. Pierce stated that his department was working on details of the registration process that he would like to see put on the DEH and the Board's website. It would be active and has links to the forms and the process.

Kris Joyce, Andre Pierce and representatives from Blue Lizard met with the Board to give a Database Report. Chair Nilla Sloop appointed Malcolm Blalock and Janice Jones to work with Kris Joyce, Andre Pierce and Blue Lizard on developing the framework for the database.

Secretary/Treasurer's Report – Ann Gilstrap

- Ms. Gilstrap opened a discussion on form letters. It was determined that Ms. Gilstrap would make corrections and revisions and send a packet to all Board Members for comments and revisions.
- A question came up regarding whether an intern, who left employment and later came back to work, would have to retake Public Health Law within four years of the date of the new employment. John Barkley stated that he would check into this and report back at a later date.
- A question was posed to Mr. Barkley regarding the minutes of a closed session. If there is to be
 discussion of closed session minutes, the Board needs to go into closed session to discuss and approve.
 If there is no discussion, the closed session minutes can be approved in open session. Closed session
 tapes are to be erased or destroyed.

Board Action: Motion made by Malcolm Blalock to go into closed session to discuss the portion of the October Minutes in regards to an investigation. Motion seconded by Mack Dendy and approved.

Went into Closed Session.

Back in Open Session at 12:11 p.m.

Nilla Sloop is still out of the room due to possible conflict of interest regarding a Wake County Investigation.

Based on the report from the investigative team, there appears to be a sufficient amount of creditable evidence in violation of 90A-64. (4), (6), (8) and (9).

Board Action: <u>Mack Dendy made a motion that the Board hold a hearing in the matter of a former Wake County EHS to consider whether any action should be taken on her registration. Seconded by Layton Long and approved. Malcolm, Ann & Terry abstained from voting.</u>

Acting Chair Terry Pierce directed Mr. Barkley to draft a notice of the Board's determination and a notice of hearing.

Chair Nilla Sloop is now present and presiding over the meeting.

Board Action: Motion made by Terry Pierce and seconded by Ann Gilstrap to reconsider action taken at the October meeting to allow the investigation in Cherokee County to remain open so that the complainant could be contacted to see if there is further evidence. All votes affirmative.

Board Action: <u>Under advice of counsel, motion to go into closed session was made by Mack Dendy and seconded by Terry Pierce.</u> All votes affirmative.

Went into Closed Session.

Back in Open Session at 12:30 p.m.

The next meeting date was set for January 31, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. at Parker Lincoln Building in Raleigh.
