# **October 2, 2008**

#### **Board Meeting**

The meeting of the NC State Board of Sanitarian Examiners was held on Thursday, October 2, 2008 at the Carteret County Health Department in Morehead City NC. Those in attendance were: Ann Gilstrap, Sheila Nichols, Malcolm Blalock, Patricia Hawkins, Lynn Lathan, Terry Pierce, Perry Solice and Janice Jones. Layton Long and Dr Burt Ogle were absent.

Called to Order - Chair Ann Gilstrap called the meeting to order at 11:05 a.m.

<u>Conflict of Interest Statement</u> – Chair Ann Gilstrap asked if any Board Member wishes to speak to the appearance of any actual or potential conflicts of interest. There were none stated. Ms. Gilstrap reminded Board members to recuse themselves when action on a staff member, family, or friend is under consideration by the Board. She also reminded Board members that they should refrain from participation in any discussions in which they may have a potential or existing conflict of interest.

# **Approval of Minutes - Janice Jones**

Minutes for the June 4, 2008 meeting were sent to all Board Members.

Board Action: Lynn Lathan made a motion to approve the Minutes. Motion was seconded by Perry Solice. All votes affirmative.

Closed session minutes were mailed to all Board Members.

Board Action: Malcolm Blalock made a motion to approve the Closed Session Minutes. Motion was seconded by Lynn Lathan. All votes affirmative.

#### **Financial Report** – Janice Jones

Janice Jones presented the Financial Report. Bank Balances as of October 1, 2008 were Checking account - \$3,408.96, Money Market account - \$5,111.66, Share account - \$33.92 and STIF account - \$34,542.64. Total of these accounts are \$43.097.18.

Board Action: <u>Terry Pierce made a motion to accept the Financial Report. Motion was seconded by Lynn Lathan.</u> All votes affirmative.

#### Chair's Report - Ann Gilstrap

Ann Gilstrap shared a report from NEHA. Fifteen states have no requirements for registration; twenty-six states have voluntary or mandatory registration with at least 30 semester hours and nine states that require something other than 30 semester hours.

Ms. Gilstrap discussed with the Board the renewal of the Insurance Bond.

# Board Action: <u>Malcolm Blalock made a motion to require only the paid employee to be bonded. Motion was seconded by Terry Pierce.</u> All votes affirmative.

Ms. Gilstrap presented the 2008 Newsletter to the Board members for review. After a few changes, the newsletter was finished. It will be sent out on the listserv and included in the mailing to the unaffiliated Registered Sanitarians.

Long length of time between scheduled Board meetings was discussed. Possible solution is to have conference calls when there is a long length of time between scheduled Board Meetings to approve RS Interns and RSs only.

Lawsuit over septic tank problem in Person County will be appealed to the Supreme Court. Board would like to recommend strengthening public official status and oath of office.

A letter received from Erin Bryan-Millush was discussed. In order to become a Registered Sanitarian Intern or a Registered Sanitarian in North Carolina, a person must be employed in a position that requires registration. Chair Gilstrap will send her a response addressing her concerns.

In reference to Internal Controls, confirmation of Self-Assessment was received.

Auditor Shelton Hawley still has the financial records for 2007, but is almost finished with the audit.

Medical Exemption from Continuing Education requirement was discussed.

Part-time employment during RS Intern status was discussed. A policy will be developed to address this matter.

It was reported that all Board Members have now completed the Ethics Training.

Ms. Gilstrap appointed Terry Pierce to chair the Nominating Committee and ask that he choose two other Board Members to serve on the committee and to report back at the December meeting with a slate of officers for 2009.
