## **EXAM APPLICATION FORM**

In order to become a Registered Environmental Health Specialist in North Carolina, an individual must be registered as an Environmental Health Specialist Intern, complete specified continuing education and training, and achieve a passing score on a comprehensive exam (REHS exam) within three years of being registered as an Intern. The examination consists of the NEHA multiple-choice exam, an Essay exam, and an Oral exam. The exam is designed to assure that Environmental Health Specialists are qualified, competent, and properly prepared to perform the duties and responsibilities of the position.

## **EXAM REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. Application and payment for the exam must be received at least 4 weeks prior to the exam date.
- 2. A picture ID must be presented to the Board before sitting for the exam.
