EXAM APPLICATION FORM

In order to become a Registered Sanitarian (RS) in North Carolina, an individual must be registered as a Sanitarian Intern, complete specified continuing education and training, and achieve a passing score on a comprehensive exam (RS exam), within three years of being registered as an Intern. The examination consists of the NEHA multiple-choice exam, an Essay exam, and an Oral exam. The RS Exam is designed to assure that Sanitarians or Environmental Health Specialists are qualified, competent, and properly prepared to perform the duties and responsibilities of the position.

EXAM REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Applications for the exam must be received at least 4 weeks prior to the exam date.
- 2. A picture ID and the exam confirmation letter must be presented to the Board before sitting for the exam.
