In order to become a Registered Environmental Health Specialist in North Carolina, an individual must be registered as an Environmental Health Specialist Intern, complete specified continuing education and training, and achieve a passing score on a comprehensive exam (REHS exam) within three years of being registered as an Intern. The examination consists of the NEHA multiple-choice exam (which counts 50% of the final score), an Essay exam (which counts 25% of the final score), and an Oral exam (which counts 25% of the final score). An applicant must score 60% or higher on each portion of the exam with an overall score of 70% or higher. The exam is designed to assure that Environmental Health Specialists are qualified, competent, and properly prepared to perform the duties and responsibilities of the position.
